

WarCats Code of Ethics for Parents

As a parent:

- I will keep my daughter's financial account in good standing, and will adhere to the deadlines to avoid penalties. I understand our player fee may not include all the cost involving travel softball.
- I understand that I cannot approach a coach with any personal playing issues just before a game or 24 hours following a tournament or game. *(This is considered a cool down period for any parent that may be upset over playing time or positions).*
- I will volunteer at our annual WarCats tournament and provide requested donations. I will volunteer before the tournament if we cannot be at the tournament.
- I will not dispute calls and decisions made by persons in authority, umpires, and coaches.
- I will provide positive support and encouragement for my daughter by demonstrating good sportsmanship (in words and actions) to all players, coaches, and umpires.
- I will support coaches working with my child and will let her coach have the priority of coaching despite my own opinions.
- I will remember this game is for the girls, not the adults.
- I will remain calm when my daughter and her teammates make a mistake.
- I will try not to take myself too seriously when it comes to spectating. I will remind myself and my daughter to have fun.
- I understand that playing time is not equal among all players and there is no guarantee of a set amount of playing time or position.

I acknowledge that I have read, understood, and will do my best to fulfill the promises made herein. Should a violation occur, the WarCats Board can take further action to penalize and enforce these rules.
